## Modern Masoretic "Biblical" Hebrew Traced to ANCIENT HEBREW ORIGINS

When using the original ancient Hebrew alphabet to translate words/names/etc. (i.e. AHAYAHA from "AHYH" in Exo. 3:14, AYASHAYA from "AYSY" in Hos. 2:16, etc.) & discover how they were originally pronounced, which is vastly different from modern Hebrew, keep in mind that, in ancient Hebrew, to spell out a word or a name is the same as pronouncing it.
