Modern Masoretic "Biblical" Hebrew Traced to ANCIENT HEBREW ORIGINS

When using the original ancient Hebrew alphabet to translate words/names/etc. (i.e. **AHAYAHA** from "AHYH" in Exo. 3:14, **AYASHAYA** from "AYS" in Hos. 2:16, etc.) & discover how they were originally pronounced, which is vastly different from modern Hebrew, keep in mind that, **in ancient Hebrew, to spell out a word or a name is the same as pronouncing it.**
